






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2-DAY ECG INTERPRETATION WORKSHOP



The Live Surgical Workshop held on May 6th at 11 am was organized in collaboration with M.A.C.C (Medical Alumni Career Club). This event took place at New Vision University, Health Hub, located at Bokhua St 9. The workshop was directed by Dr. Lasha Gulbani, a renowned general surgeon at American Hospital in Tbilisi and Gudushauri Hospital, as well as a professor at CIU (Caucasus International University). The workshop had a total of 50 participants who were interested in enhancing their surgical skills and knowledge. The event was designed to be informative and enjoyable.



After a short break, the second surgical session commenced at 1:45 pm. During this session, the participants were provided with stitching kits for a hands-on approach to learning. The surgeon demonstrated different stitching techniques, and the participants were given the opportunity to practice and improve their stitching skills under guidance. The participants also gained knowledge about the necessary preparations for surgery, such as proper handwashing, wearing gloves and gowns.

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
procedures, which will be crucial in their future medical practice, such as:

- Inserting an IUD (Intrauterine Device): Participants received hands-on training on how to insert this contraceptive device in a safe and effective manner.
- Leopold's Maneuver: Participants learned how to perform this technique, which helps assess the position of the fetus and its presentation in the mother's abdomen during pregnancy.
- Pap Smear: Participants probably learned how to collect and process cervical samples for Pap smears, a vital screening test for cervical cancer.

The practical nature of the workshop, with hands-on training and guidance from an experienced professional like Dr. Ana Merkviladze, undoubtedly enriched the learning experience for the attendees.

NEUROLOGY EMG WORKSHOP: DR. MADONNA

The Electromyography workshop conducted by Dr. Madonna Sekhniashvili on May 18th was held at New Vision University, Health Hub. The event was exclusive to GIMSOC members. 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SPECIAL TALK WITH DR JASMINA

Her insights into working under such conditions have provided valuable learning for the audience, giving them a better understanding of the realities faced by healthcare professionals in conflict regions.

Moreover, Dr. Jasmina discussed potential ways to further improve medical assistance in war zones and areas of conflict, focusing on what more can be done to support both medical personnel and patients in such environments.
